NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$.0600 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Medina County Emergency Service District #3.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$.0600 per \$100

NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$.0641 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$.0665 per \$100

DE MINIMIS RATE \$.0898 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the <u>2025</u> tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for <u>Medina County Emergency Service District #3</u> from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Medina County Emergency Service District #3 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for Medina County Emergency Service District #3 exceeds the voter-approval tax rate for Medina County Emergency Service District #3.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for <u>Medina County Emergency Service District #3</u>, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for <u>Medina County Emergency Service District #3</u>.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Medina County Emergency Service District #3 is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 08, 2025 at 4pm at 3006 Avenue G, Hondo, TX 78861.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, <u>Medina County Emergency Service District #3</u> is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the <u>Medina County Emergency Service District #3</u> at their office or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
